### Los Belones

Los Belones is the nearest village to La Manga Club. To reach Los Belones, go straight over the first mini-roundabout at the end of the main road out of the Club and turn right at the second roundabout Shops Include:

Bakers (Panaderia), Newsagents (Prensa), Butchers (Carniceria), Hardware/gift items, Tobacconist (Estanco), Fishmonger (Pescaderia), Supermarkets (Supermercado) Furniture (Muebles), Chemist (Farmacia), Wine Shop (Bodega), Optician (optica), Electrical Shop.

### Cartagena (30 mins)

Plenty of shops within walking distance including El Cortes Ingles (the hotel arranges shopping trips on Wednesdays to this large department store. Please contact the hotel reception for information. Also Zara, Mango and jewellery shops. There's even a McDonald's!

### Murcia (40 mins)

Excellent selection of shops with major department stores, including the original El Corte Ingles, which is a must if you visit Murcia.

### Supermarkets

There are two large hypermarkets in Cartagena. There are also two supermarkets just before Cabo de Palos called Upper and Mercadona. It is wise to visit one of these supermarkets at the beginning of your holiday to stock up on drinks etc. All of these Supermarkets are open all day, Upper is also open on a Sunday morning.

The street markets can be fascinating and are well worth a visit and are on the following mornings: -

**Sunday** - Cabo de Palos, Puerto de Mazarron, Los Nietos and San Javier
